ADULT FARM MANAGEMENT JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Description is:

- Recruit students and develop work load of 40 50 members over a 4(5) year period, and maintain or exceed this number. Annually accept new students.
- 2. Develop short and long term goals with and for each student.
- 3. Use the University of Minnesota Farm Management course of study as it applies to the students' short and long term goals.
- 4. Follow the Vocational Division, State Department of Education's rules and regulations.
- Provide scheduled classroom instruction on a group basis for students enrolled.
- 6. Design a year around program which meets the requirements of the students.
- 7. Include an annual Minnesota Vo-Ag Farm Business Management analysis for each student as an integral part of the program.
- 8. Instructor shall meet and follow the certification requirements of the State of Minnesota.
- 9. Provide and emphasize individualized on-farm instruction.
- 10. Organize an effective advisory committee to plan a relevant program in Farm Management education for the students.
